The successful company/companies will be expected to provide the technical expertise in terms of planning & design, tendering, monitoring the project implementation, etc.

Documents (MBD) will be available from Thulamela Municipality's Procurement office as from **22 November 2016** upon a non- refundable cash payment of R 539-00.

Bidding companies are required to submit the bid documents with the following compulsory requirements:

- ✍ Valid tax clearance certificate issued by SARS.
- ✍ Company registration documents.
- ✍ Valid proof of registration for Professional Indemnity Insurance.
- ✍ Proof of Professional Registration of proposed project leader / manager.
- ✍ CVs of the proposed project team, and their office location.
- ✍ Similar previously executed projects with contract values and client's contact details.
- ✍ Companies' and/or Directors' proof of payment for the Municipal accounts (rates & taxes) in their area of jurisdiction, not older than 3 months and not in arrears for more the 90 days.

Where possible we also request to be provided with the company profile and CSD report. (Please note that the municipality will only do business with service providers registered on the CSD.

NB: Service providers must submit their certified BBBEE verification certification from verification agency accredited by South Africa accreditation system (SANAS) or registered auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the corporation and BEE Rating certification.

Bids will be assessed under the provisions of the following Acts and its Regulations: Municipal Finance Management Act, (Act 56 of 2003); PPPFA, Supply Chain Management Policy of the municipality in accordance with the specifications and in terms of 90:10 preferential points system and functionality.
