Children's rights in South Africa are protected by International, Continental and National laws. Three primary sources of law pertaining to children's rights are the 1990 United Nations Convention on the Rights of The Child, the 1990 Africa Charter on The Rights and Welfare of the Child, and the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa.

These instruments guarantee the rights for children and families essential to the health, wellbeing and optimal development of all children.

Section 28 of the bill of rights enshrined in the South Africa Constitution guarantees every child the right to social services. Every child has the right to basic nutrition, basic health care services and social services

It is therefore our responsibility to ensure that children who are brought to Social Development homes have enabling documents such as ID and birth Certificate in order to benefit from most of programmes that have been developed and being implemented by Government to realize the Socio-Economic rights guaranteed by the constitution.

Lets us join together to further enhance our valued principles of community responsiveness as we conclude Mandela month where various activities were held across the world in response to global call of giving on minutes of our time to good course. We are here today as part of a global call of action to try to brighten the children's day by spending 67 minutes and spreading our love in Madiba name. Our commitment towards the normalization of child need should be communicated to all constituencies, including communities believing that communities are not passive recipients of development work.
