Tshikhudini United FC triumphant in second Maanea Soccer Tournament

Muswodi-Dipeni businessman and farmer Alphens Musinyali has increased the prizes for winners of his Maanea Soccer Tournament, which aims to promote sport and keep

young people away from crime in rural communities. Musinyali plans to make the tournament a monthly event to provide a safe and engaging weekend activity for locals.

Tshikhudini United FC from

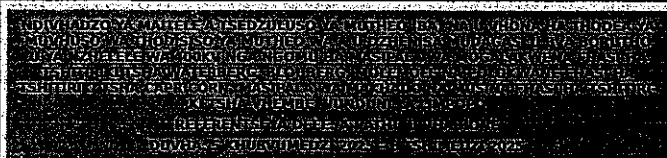
Folovhodwe village, an affiliate of the Musina Local Football Association (MLFA), won the second Maanea Soccer Tournament, beating Lwathudwa Black Movers 1-0 at the Maanea sports ground on Sunday, 31 August. The team received R10,000 and a trophy.

Tournament organiser Joe Manenzhe said 16 teams from the Ntami area had participated, with hundreds of community members attending. The runners-up, Makavhini Black Movers, won R5,000, while teams finishing third and

fourth received R1,500 each, and teams in fifth to eighth place got R500. Tshikhudini United goalkeeper and captain Walter Ndou, also known as Malamba, was awarded a trophy for Man of the Match. Musinyali said the tourna-

ment was one of his proudest achievements.

"I used to see young people loitering and abusing alcohol, but during the soccer tournament they are kept busy and focused," he said.

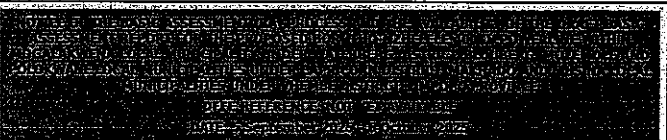

Notice is given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in Government Notice (GNR) 982 in Gazette No. 3822 of 4 December 2014 (as amended), of Intent by the National Transmission Company South Africa SOC Ltd (NTCSA), a subsidiary of Eskom Holdings SOC Limited to apply with the Department of Forestry, Fisheries, and the Environment (DFFE) for an Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the construct and operate a ±250km, 400 KV powerline from the existing Borutho Main Transmission Substation (MTS) to the existing Nzelele MTS within the Limpopo Province.

Project Location: The proposed powerline spans across several farms in the following six local municipalities: Mogalakwena, Polokwane, Molemole, Blouberg, Makhado, and Musina, under the jurisdiction of three district municipalities: Waterberg, Capricorn, and Vhembe, in Limpopo Province. Borutho MTS is approximately 30km north-west of Mokopane within the Mogalakwena Local Municipality, while Nzelele MTS is approximately 37km south-west of Musina within the Musina Local Municipality. The proposed powerline transects a railway line, the national highway (N1), regional roads (R521, R523, and R567), as well as local access roads. Several villages, such as Jupiter, Venus, Sefahlane, Ga-Magongoo, Danplaats, Ga-Madikana, Ga-Phago, Maribana, Vivo, Alldays, Sekuruwe, and Kalkbank, are in close proximity to the proposed powerline.

EIA Process: The proposed scope of works are listed within Listing Notice 1, GNR 983: Activities 12 and 19; Listing Notice 2, GNR 984: Activity 9; and Listing Notice 3, GNR 985: Activities 4, 12 and 14. As the project area falls within the International Strategic Transmission Corridor, a Basic Assessment Process is being followed in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). NTCSA has therefore appointed Vhubvo Consultancy as the Environmental Assessment Practitioners (EAP).

Other Permits: The proposed project will also require a Water Use Licence (WUL) General Authorisation (GA) in terms of Section 21(c) and (i) of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998), flora and fauna permits in terms of Section 15(1) of the National Forest Act, 1998 (NFA), Section 88(1) of the National Environmental Management Biodiversity Act, 2004 (NEMBA) and Section 64(1) of the Limpopo Environmental Management Act, 2003 (LEMA). Vhubvo will lodge the applications with the relevant government departments.

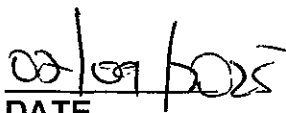

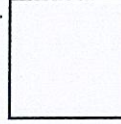
