Tshiozwi Mates narrowly beat Madodonga United 1-0 in their Makhado Local Football Association promotional playoff match at the Ravele Grounds on Saturday.

Mates will now be promoted to the SAFA Vhembe Stream E league, which starts later this month.

Mates pressed United in the first 20 minutes of the clash. Their speedy forward, Kulani Mapengo, let them down by shooting aimlessly at the goal. Mates tried to rectify the mistake soon afterwards. Their diminutive kingpin, Mushoni Mavhandu, beat the offside trap but lost possession with keeper Andivhahlo Ndlovu at his mercy.

Mates played defensive football in the first half, allowing their opponents to spend a lot of time in their territory. The referee flashed the first yellow card in the 30th minute when Mphariseni Muskwana of Mates was reprimanded for a dangerous tackle on Maselo Lishivha.

The only time United came close to scoring was when Humbulani Muvhali broke loose from the left flank and shot wide from close range. At that stage, the game was 34 minutes old.

The goal that separated the boys from the men came in the 74th minute. Mates were awarded a free kick, and Tshedza Mutandari scored from the set-piece spot.

Late in the game, United should have equalised, but Khomoto's Khosa's ground cutter hit the woodwork and bounced back into play, much to the disappointment of the team's fans.

Record turnout for second annual Musina Top Runners Marathon

Scores of runners from local and neighbouring areas had an active morning in Musina when they participated in the Musina Top Runners Marathon on Saturday, 6 September, at the Musina MAC Rugby Field.

The second annual marathon, organised by the Musina Top Runners Club, kicked off at 06:30 and attracted clubs

from as far afield as Polokwane. The club's chairperson, Lufuno Musenwa, said the main aim of the marathon was to promote social cohesion, inspired by the club's participation in marathons in Polokwane, Soweto, and the Comrades Marathon.

"It was all a dream. Seeing people from other places like Polokwane ignited my desire to take it home. We managed as a team because everyone played a vital role," Musenwa

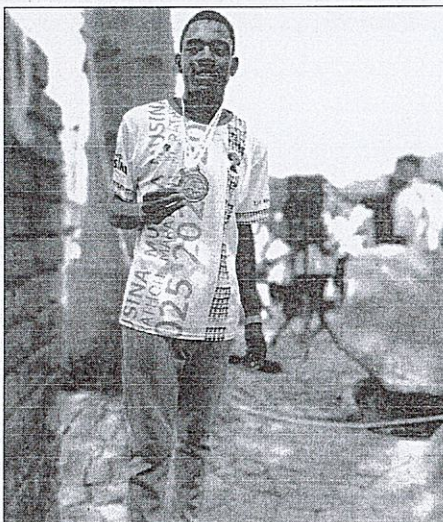
said.

The race is recognised as an official marathon by Athletics South Africa and serves as a qualifier for both the Comrades and the Two Oceans marathon. This year, 1,035 runners registered, up from 425 last year. The total prize money was R52,000.

Stella Dhokotera, from the Beitbridge organising committee for runners Running Is Our Therapy (RIOT), took first place in her category. "I feel good to have won. For me it was not about money, but about my health and networking with other runners from different clubs. I lost 38kg while preparing for this marathon. Now I am going to prepare for the marathon on 20 September," she said.

Coach and mentor Makoro Makhumisane of AWF was pleased with his runners' performance. Out of seven participants, three took first place in their respective categories. Makwarela Ramavhane (15) won the 5km race, Muano Ramalivhana (17) claimed the 10km event, and Robber Baloyi (18) finished first in his category in the 21km race at third overall.

"For me, it is a step in the right direction. My runners always aim for the best, because I tell them it is all or nothing. The prize money will motivate them to continue aiming high. Makhumisane said.
