1.3.	THIS BID IS SUBJECT TO THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT AND THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017, THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) AND, IF APPLICABLE, ANY OTHER SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT.

The bidders should also download SCM forms that are found in the Documents SCM-FORMS folder on the website and complete as part of the Bid documents.

The service providers must submit the completed Bid documents (in black ink) and hand deliver or courier them to Thulamela Municipality. All completed Bid documents (hand delivered or couriered) must be dropped in the BID BOX before the closing date and time of the Bids' closure. The onus is on the service providers to make sure the Bid documents are submitted on time and late submission won't be accepted.

Interested service providers must attend a compulsory briefing session (for BID No: 38/2025/2026 and BID No. 39/2025/2026) on 07 July 2026 at 11h00. Venue: Thulamela local Municipality: Tshilungoma Mechanical Workshop.

Interested service providers will be expected to submit the Bid documents with the following compulsory requirements. Tax Compliance Status Letter or Tax Compliance Pin Number.

- Company registration documents (e.g. CK).
- Proof of registration on Central Supplier Database (CSD).
- Certified copy of partnership or Joint Venture (JV) agreement (if bidders is a partnership or JV)
- Certified and Valid proof of registration with Retail Motor Industry (RMI)
- Bidders must submit proof that municipal rates and taxes for both the company and its director(s) are not in arrears for more than three (3) months, and such proof must not be older than three (3) months from the date of advertisement. Where the business operates from leased premises, a valid lease agreement must be attached. Where a director does not own property or is renting, a valid lease agreement must also be provided. If the bidder resides or operates in an area where municipal services are not billed, an official signed and stamped letter from the relevant local municipality, not older than three (3) months from the date of advertisement, must be submitted confirming that the area is not subject to municipal billing and that the bidder is formally exempt from municipal service charges.

NEGOTIATING A FAIR MARKET RELATED PRICE: A process for negotiating with preferred bidders after a competitive bidding process or price quotations will be considered for Bids where more than one (1) service provider is appointed.

This may include amongst others the following principles:

- Delegations and threshold values for negotiating by the accounting officer
- Negotiating may not allow any preferred tenderer a second or unfair opportunity
- Is not to the detriment of any other tenderer
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The award of the tender may be subjected to price negotiation with the preferred tenderers.

The Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest Bid and reserves the right to accept any part of a Bid. Bids must remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after closing date of the submission thereof.

Site Inspection and Verification of Workshop Facilities

The Municipality will conduct physical inspections of the workshop facilities, offices, equipment, tools, and operational resources of bidders who qualify for appointment or are shortlisted for appointment. The purpose of the inspection will be to verify the information submitted in the bid and to confirm that the bidder has access to a fully equipped workshop, suitable tools and equipment, and appropriately qualified artisan(s) capable of providing the required maintenance and repair services for the municipal fleet.

Failure by the bidder to demonstrate the availability of a fully functional workshop, necessary equipment, or suitably qualified artisan(s) during the inspection may result in disqualification from the appointment process or termination of the contract where applicable.

The Municipality will verify qualifications, trade certificates, workshop facilities, and any other information provided by the bidder.

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NB: Bids which are late, incomplete, unsigned, completed by pencil, sent by telegraph, facsimile, electronically (Fax), or E-mail and without the compulsory requirements will be disqualified.

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
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
